A devoted member of St. Michaels Anglican Church in Clarks Town, Beverley served faithfully throughout her life and continued to do so even while living in Florida. Her love for God and dedication to her faith and her community were her sources of strength. She had the ability to make everyone feel appreciated. Whether it was through her smile, thoughtful words, phone calls, or her cooking, she brought joy to those who crossed her path.

Beverley was predeceased by her husband, Brian, and son, Bruce. She will be fondly remembered as a loving wife, devoted mother, dedicated daughter, cherished grandmother, and a beloved sister, aunt, cousin, and friend.
