Edenia Salome Brown (“Moni”, nee Marrero) 1932-2024

Moni passed away peacefully at 92 on the evening of December 27, 2024. She was the 7th of 8 children born to Jose Felipe Marrero and Leandra Maria Gonzales in the town of Bolondrón, Matanzas, Cuba. Moni was a resident of Highland Meadows in Deerfield since 1995, though most recently moved to Wickshire in Tamarac. Moni was happily married for 25 years to Ken Brown of Indiana (d.Dec.1998). She loved dancing, singing, reading, and sewing, and was an excellent seamstress who was able to use her abilities into her 90’s.
