Evangeline Ducasse Johnson was born on May 30, 1941 in Kingston, Jamaica. She was the last child born to Luna and Charles Ducasse and was affectionately known to family and friends as Vangie. She devoted her life to Christ at an early age and attended St. Stephens United Church.

In 1966, she left Jamaica and moved to Toronto, Canada. Evangeline moved to New York in 1968 where she worked in the microbiology department of the Cornell University Medical College. During this time she was also an active member of the Bronx Baptist Church where she sang soprano in the choir. In 1973, Evangeline moved to South Florida, married and found her true calling as a loving and nurturing mother to her four children. Evangeline worked multiple jobs and focused her efforts on raising her children as a single mother in Miramar, FL. In retirement, Evangeline moved to Tamarac, FL.
