Gertrude Marie Lasseur (1940-2016)

Departed to heaven on August 9, 2016 in West Palm Beach, FL. at age 76.

Mrs. Gertrude Marie Lasseur (formally Gertrude Marie Michel) saw her first day light in Croix-des-Bouquets, Haiti on the 14th of April 1940. The first of 10 children born to Delinois and Vesta Michel, Gertrude proved to be a great leader from an early age. Upon completion of her general studies in Haiti, she continued on to pursue a degree in Theology at Séminaire de Théologie Évangélique de Port-Au-Prince (Bolosse) where she met her late husband Rev. Paul Fatil Lasseur. The couple later attended Winston-Salem State College in Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

In 1966, Rev. Paul and Gertrude Lasseur migrated to Freeport, Bahamas and founded the Bethany Baptist Missionary Society. From there, they continued to spread the word of God while planting numerous churches in The Bahamas, throughout south Florida, and in several sectors of Haiti. In addition to being an extraordinary pillar in the Haitian-Christian community, Gertrude was a remarkable mother and provider to her five children. Despite the many challenges that life presented, Gertrude used her gift as an entrepreneur to support not only her immediate family, but also countless ministries abroad.

On August 9th, 2016 at 1045pm, Gertrude departed from this Earth to meet her Lord and Savior after a courageous battle with a chronic illness. The world has lost a great woman of God, a woman of incredible faith and beautiful spirit. Gertrude was a woman who refused to let the trials of life hold her back. She was a dream catcher, and a visionary who inspired all of those who loved her. Aside from being an exceptional individual, Gertrude was a wonderful mother, grandmother, great grandmother, sister, aunt, cousin and beyond. She truly was her family's anchor and a fervent pioneer for the gospel of Jesus Christ. It was her total submission to the Lord that led her to becoming a historical and passionate ministry founder in the Haitian community. She was a well versed historian, a hilarious storyteller and powerful evangelist.

Gertrude's firm grasp on a Christianity led her entire family to salvation. Her work as a servant of God is impeccable and will never be forgotten. May her legacy live through us as she will forever remain the pillar of her family. Though she will be dearly missed here on Earth, Mrs. Gertrude's family and loved ones can rest assured knowing that she is now reunited in heaven with her loving husband (Rev. Paul F. Lasseur) and beloved son (Mark E. Lasseur).
