



Maurice Fitz- Herbert Johnson

August 8, 1948 - June 12, 2025

Maurice Fitz-Herbert Johnson, 76, passed away on June 12, 2025, in Sunrise, Florida. Born on August 8, 1948, in Kingston, Jamaica, he lived a life marked by curiosity, resilience, and a deep appreciation for knowledge and the world around him. Maurice was the first of five children born to Claude and Daphne Johnson. He spent his formative years in Jamaica before moving with his family to the Bronx, New York. As a child, he enjoyed looking after his younger siblings, and he developed a close bond with his grandmother, Lena Rodman.

Maurice's early years laid the foundation for a lifelong pursuit of learning. He graduated from Ardenne High School in Kingston, Jamaica. After graduating from high school, he continued his education by earning an Associate's Degree from Miami Dade Community College. His academic journey reflected his inquisitive nature and desire to understand the intricacies of both science and life. In the 1970s, Maurice married, and the union created his four beloved children, Marcel, Janice, Geoffrey, and Karen. The couple originally settled in Carol City, Florida, and under Maurice's leadership, the family moved to Miramar, Florida as the children began their education. In the mid-2000s, Maurice met and married Merlyne Brown. The couple lived in Miami Gardens, Florida, and the union lasted until his death.

Professionally, Maurice was first employed by the Jamaican Ministry of Agriculture Fishing and Mining. After immigrating to the United States, he

worked as a chemist at Revlon Research and Development Laboratory in New Jersey. After moving to Miami, he worked for Saxon Corporation during the early 1980s. His analytical mind and entrepreneurial spirit led him to explore other ventures. Maurice launched Alcoh Business Systems in the mid-1980s, which specialized in office equipment sales and service. Maurice brought the same determination and creativity to his professional career that defined every aspect of his life.

Maurice was known not only for his professional accomplishments but also for his vibrant personality. He was strong-willed and confident—a true fighter who approached challenges with optimism and resolve. He expressed this tenacity through his study of martial arts, especially Judo. His generosity touched many lives, and those who knew him often found themselves inspired by his thoughtful insights and curiosity. Maurice would provide advice on countless topics including science, history, and philosophy.

A passionate collector, Maurice found joy in surrounding himself with items that sparked wonder—timepieces, lamps, and countless other treasures filled his world. Maurice loved music and had a large collection of albums spanning many musical genres. He also loved cars and was particularly fond of his sky-blue metallic Datsun 280z. Each item told a story or represented a moment of discovery.

Family was central to Maurice's life. He is survived by his beloved wife of over 20 years, Merlyne; his children Marcel Johnson (Aimee), Janice Shaw (Michael), Geoffrey Johnson (Aiasha), and Karen Johnson; and his cherished grandchildren Sydney, Elizabeth, Laila, Madeline, Geoffrey II, Emma, Avery, and Victoria. He also leaves behind his brothers Carl Johnson (Judith), Claude Johnson Jr. (Sue), and sister Sonia Johnson. He is also survived by many nieces, nephews, and friends.

He was preceded in death by his father Claude Johnson Sr., mother Daphne Johnson, and sister Janet Angela Crawford. Maurice's legacy is one of strength, generosity, curiosity, and love—a legacy that will live on through the memories shared by those who knew him best.
