



## Melvina Amritt

September 4, 1946 - June 5, 2018

Melvina Oriela (Skervin) Barker-Amritt was born on September 4, 1946 to the parents of Claudious and Octavia Delpratt-Skervin in the parish of St. Thomas, Jamaica.

In those early days in St. Thomas, Melvina (Mel or “Little Miss”) received an early education up to the 8th grade, but excelled informally until she came to the United States where she received her High School equivalency.

Mel immigrated to Canada in 1973 then later to the United States in 1976 where she worked as a certified nursing assistant until her retirement.

Mel was a faithful disciple of her Lord Jesus Christ. She was an active member of Christian Life Center in Fort Lauderdale, FL. She was involved in the choir, outreach ministry, Life Group and various areas of ministries.
