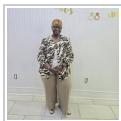

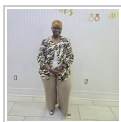

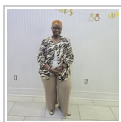
Oh Crystal, I just remember about the train too. Anywhere I wanted to go, ask Aunt Norma, she could always tell you which train to take to get there.
