“ To The Nicholson Family

Firstly, I would like to extend my very heartfelt condolences on the passing of your dear son, husband and father Omar, who in 1984-1985 was my best friend in Form 3 O at Wolmer's Boys' School, where we both were students.

We had not unbelievably seen each other since then and I had lost contact with him, but the laughter and memories we shared as friends that year will remain with me forever.

Prior to 3rd Form, we had known each other in passing and were actually in the same 1st Form Class, 1 C as I recall it. Despite playing for the class football team in 1st Form, it was in 3rd Form when we were sat beside each other that we really came to know each other.

Omar was at the same time funny and very intellectual as I recall it. In Maths and Physics in particular he was brilliant and Thank God! He helped me many a time in doing various calculations in Physics, which I never quite mastered and Maths, especially Sine, Cosine & Tangents.

I remember once in our lighter moments, he was speaking with some other students and describing how he "Ran a Boat" with some of his friends in his neighborhood. I was listening in and he asked me, "You know what I mean when I say, we a run a boat by the Gully?"

Being the typical uptown youth I was, I had no idea, but thought I did. When I responded by saying "Yes, you mean you made some paper boats and raced them down the gully when it flooded!" The whole group erupted in laughter. He too laughed, then explained to me that "To run a boat" meant cooking food. Thank God for his clarification as this spared me further embarrassment in years to come!

Omar or "Sticky" as we called him back then was a brilliant footballer. I remember him for his defensive skills as we marshaled the defense for Form 3 O, which was the "Los Galacticos" of our Year at Wolmer's.

After the summer break, sadly, Omar did not come back for 4th Form. I knew he had gone to Florida as he told me he would be doing so for the summer, but I never saw nor heard from him again, although I would get updates from mutual friends from time to time.

I likewise migrated a few years later. When I went on to 4th Form (4 O), the guys in our class had a running joke to say that "Sticky was filing for me to come to America."

It was by sheer coincidence that I learnt of Omar's passing today via Google. I was and still am shocked and saddened even as I write this.

Brilliant, thoughtful, funny and kind are my recollections of my dear friend.

To his father, Mr. Nicholson and mother I know this cannot be the easiest of times for you and I pray your strength and that of his wife and widow Tracey-Ann and sons Sebastian and Christian, in Jesus' Name. May The Holy Spirit Himself comfort, heal and strengthen you all in this time of mourning.

It does not surprise me to learn that Omar went on to accomplish great things in life, as the seeds of greatness were evident from our time at Wolmer's. Age Quod Agis.
