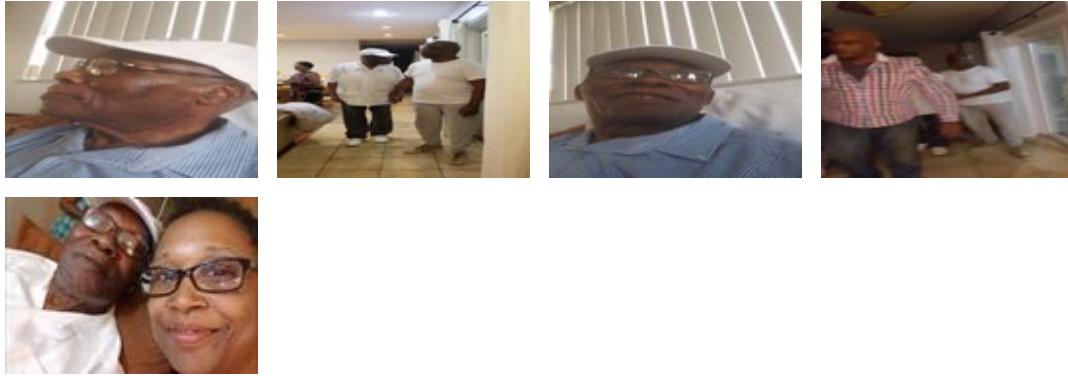

“ Eulogy: Oscar Wellington Colley

Dad was born in Westmoreland, Jamaica, on March 28th, 1933, to Charles and Mary Mulvina Colley. At an early age he moved to the Parish of Clarendon, to live with one of his uncles, Edwin. Dad was an outstanding student and a favorite of all his teachers. He often missed out on class time because he was selected by his teachers to carry out special duties which took time away from his lessons.

His mother was a woman of prayer who instilled strong, moral, Christian values into her nine children and numerous grandchildren. Dad grew up knowing the fear of the Lord, yet not submitting to Him until later into his adulthood. Dad recounted many stories of his spiritual encounters with His heavenly father and how God called him to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ. He demonstrated an undying love for his siblings. He never quite got over the loss of his beloved brother Mankel, who passed away as a young adult, and with whom he had an unbreakable bond. He had a strong sense of duty to his kinsmen and an unconditional love for his family.

This laid the foundation for him being an exemplary father, a role model to his children, and a loving and devoted husband to our mother Eula, whom he met when they were in their teen years. The marriage produced five children, the eldest of which was deceased as an infant. Dad was the priest of his family, leading us into daily morning and evening devotions, diligently expounding the Word, and teaching us the fear of God. Thereby laying a sound foundation for the future generations. We can still hear Dad's illustrious, resounding voice, bellowing out those Scripture passages, forever imprinting them in our hearts.

Dad's passion was always to advocate for those who were less fortunate. This led him to take an active role in the political arena even though he never ran for a political office. Instead he pursued the call of God upon his life and entered the Fairview Bible College where he received his ministerial credentials. He later became an associate pastor of the Castel Mount Church of the Nazarene, in Westmoreland, Jamaica. Dad devoted his life to sharing the Good News of the Gospel to all those he met. He seldom parted company with anyone without first requesting that prayer be offered up.

Dad's love, devotion, and commitment to our mom was unequalled, even to the very end, and likewise, so was mom's to Dad. Mom fiercely, and lovingly watched over her husband, cared for, and advocated for him, even as he was no longer able to do so for himself. Our father's life has been characterized by his Christian principles, devotion to His Heavenly Father, his dignified manner, his love and loyalty to his family, his mark of distinction in all areas of his life, and his qualities as a gentleman. Dad was respected, loved and admired by all who had the pleasure of meeting him. He has left an indelible mark in our lives. As the Apostle Paul states in 2 Timothy 4: 7-8, we know our Dad has fought a good fight. He has finished his course, he has kept the faith, and henceforth there is laid up for him a

crown of righteousness which the Lord the righteous judge, shall give him at that day: and not only to him, but to all those who love His appearing.

Dad was preceded in death by his parents Charles and Mary Colley, his brothers Mankel Collie, Authur Collie, Derby Collie; his sisters Gretel Collie, Ersey Levy, and Castel Desport. He is survived by Sisters Mabel Collie, Estelle Collie and Ethel Lindo; his four children Yvonne Rankine and her husband Trevor, Chris Collie, and his wife Patricia Montague Collie, Michael Collie, Eveth Colley, grandchildren -Crystal Hill, Ivana Rankine, Christina Collie, Sarah Collie, Samantha Collie, Julianne Collie, Adrienne Collie, and Jaspreet Collie, nieces Sophia Sinclair, Elaine Seymour, nephew Mark Sinclair whom he raised with his children, and a host of other nieces and nephews and friends.

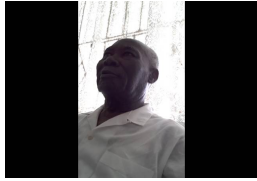
